

Details of FLOOD RELIEF activities done: AUGUST 2019

Similar to last year, Kerala is facing mass flood in this year also. Last year more devastation was felt on the southern Kerala but this year it is in northern Kerala especially Malappuram, Wayanad, Kozhikode, Palghat and Kannur districts. Considering the grim situation RECCASEWASOCIETY decided to undertake relief activities like last year. Our SEWA member Shri Gopalakrishnan and U.Venugopal contacted authorities in Kozhikode collectrate, which was acting as the nodal point for distribution of relief materials and d assessed the immediate requirements and purchased items given in the table below at a total cost of Rs. 9,883 and handed over to the authorities on 11-08-2019.

Subsequently it was brought to our notice that NIT was organizing relief activities through NSS under the leadership of Prof. Reghu. Hence it was decided to channelize our activities through them so that distribution can be more effective.

Shri Gopalakrishnan and U. Venugopal had a detailed discussion with Prof. Reghu and assessed the requirements. Based on general suggestions the following items were ordered and paid for on 12.08.2019 & 13.08.2019 to be delivered to NIT for redistribution through NSS volunteers directly to affected households. (Sri.Raghu C E C, coordinator). These were transported on 13.08.2019 to NIT.

The following is the list of materials delivered to NIT which are sufficient for **100 (ONE HUNDRED)** individual house kits:

The items transported are in bulk as obtained from Big bazaar at wholesale rates. Repacking bags are also included in the above load for repackaging the same into 100 individual kits. The items are procured as per requirement conveyed to us.

All the above items have been delivered to NIT by 4 pm on 13.08.2019. The NSS volunteers have repacked the same into 100 individual kits for distribution.

The total value of these purchases comes to Rs. 1,08,493 /-

The total amount of flood relief activity till now comes to 9883 + 108493 = 1,18,376/-.

Payments weremade by Gopalakrishnan and will be transferred from our account.

Shri. Gopalakrishnan and Shri. U.Venugopal have done an excellent job of procuring this large quantity of materials and effecting timely delivery at NIT at such short time. SEWA Executive committee expresses our sincere appreciation to their service. With further receipt of funds more relief activities can be undertaken.

In the last year flood relief activities RECCA SEWA SOCIETY could carry out remarkable works only because of generous contributions from our members and organisations like NITCAA US, NITCAA 94, SGMOC Philadelphia. We had a leftover of Rs. 1.62 lakhs which we were planning to utilize for some needy relief works. From this an amount of Rs. 50,000 is already committed for another project. Balance amount is Rs. 1.12 lakhs. Subsequently we have received Rs.40000 from our

members. Till now we have made an expenditure of Rs. 1,18,376 /- and also have committed an expenditure of Rs 12,000 /- for relief works at Wayanad. Future relief activities are in the pipelines.

RECCA SEWA SOCIETY expresses our sincere gratitude to NITCAA USA and SGMOC Philadelphia who through our member Thomas Joseph allowed us to utilize this leftover for Flood Relief activities and execute through NIT NSS volunteers coordinated by Dr Paul Joseph at NITC We also express our sincere gratitude to all our members who have now contributed for this recent flood relief activities.
